Teachers' Classroom Project Grant
Guidelines for Submitting

- A copy of grant application will be available to any Stark County Public School teacher. The applicant must be a Stark County Educator.
- Each application must include signature of building administrator
- The award must be used for a classroom project which is not reimbursed by the Board. of Education.
- Additional training will be limited to the field in which the recipient is presently employed.
- Funded projects will have the funds sent to the school system's treasurer's office. The teacher awarded the grant will obtain the funds from the school district treasurer.
- Be sure to complete all areas of the application form.
- Application must be computer generated.
- Application must be received by the deadline.*
- A teacher or team of educators may submit only one application.
- There may be more than one application per building and/or district.
- The grant recipient(s) or district treasurer shall send a summary of expenses to Stark County Retired Teachers Association (SCRTA). If possible the recipient(s) will present the project and results at the May 9, 2025 luncheon meeting of SCRTA . If unable to attend the meeting, the recipient **MUST** submit a summary that will be presented at the May 9th meeting. This may be a power-point, a video, or a written summary.
- The total amount of the grant must be used in the fiscal year of application.
